Find Unit Ratios

- 2 Methods
 - a. proportion
 - b. divide

Unit rate is the rate per one unit. Unit rates can be found by division or by proportion.

Example. 20 tickets cost \$100, find the cost per ticket, the unit rate. Cost/ ticket; \$100/20, which equals 5/1 or \$5 per ticket.

Hint: Money typically is written in the numerator
