## Find Unit Ratios

2 Methods
a. proportion
b. divide

Unit rate is the rate per one unit. Unit rates can be found by division or by proportion.

Example. 20 tickets cost $\$ 100$, find the cost per ticket, the unit rate. Cost/ ticket; $\$ 100 / 20$, which equals $5 / 1$ or $\$ 5$ per ticket. $2 0 \longdiv { 1 0 0 }$

Hint: Money typically is written in the numerator
