Teachers should help students organize their notebook so they can study effectively and efficiently and have white space so there is no visual overload.

Teachers should pace the students' note-taking as well as pace them through guided practice problems. Students should be able to review from their notes how concepts and skills were developed, as well as seeing definitions, formulas, procedures and practice problems.

Parents should be able to follow student notes so they can become more engaged their child's educational experience and help with the material.

Teachers should also use the star highlighting system in their notes based on what is going to be tested.
