

Test Prep

Two or three days *before* the unit/chapter test, teachers will pace their students through the parallel constructed practice test using the test template, *one problem at a time*. That is, the students do #1, then the teacher does #1, this process continues to the last question. This is the last time teachers will be able to monitor student understanding before the exam.

If students show hesitancy or cannot do a problem, the teacher can do that problem in class and provide further clarification and practice the following day – before the real exam.

Cheerleading

While going through the practice test, the teacher continually tells the students they know how to do these problems, they have been doing these problems, they are going to make a 100% on the test. Also remind that it is NOT acceptable to miss a 3-star question. And, 3-star questions help with 2-star questions.
