

Multiplying Fractions


So here's what 1/3 of a unit might look like.



Now, what I will do is take $\frac{1}{2}$ of that $\frac{1}{3}$ and shade that green.

$$\frac{1}{2}$$
 of $\frac{1}{3} = \frac{1}{6}$





$$\frac{2}{3}$$
 of $\frac{1}{4} = \frac{2}{12}$

Algorithm for Multiplying Fractions

- 1. Make sure you have proper or improper fractions
- 2. Cancel, if possible
- 3. Multiply numerators
- 4. Multiply denominators
- 5. Simplify
