Common Denominator

Common denominator is a number that is a multiple of all the denominators

A common denominator is a denominator that all other denominators will divide into evenly

4 Methods of Finding a Common Denominator

- 1. Multiply the denominators
- 2. Write multiples of each denominator, use a common multiple
- 3. Use a factor tree and find the Least Common Multiple
- 4. Use the Reducing Method, especially for larger numbers
