- 8. There were 120 candies in a jar. If 38 candies were taken out, and then 25 more were added, how many candies are in the jar now?
- 9. Susan had 55 stickers, and she decided to give 23 stickers to her friend. After that, she received 15 stickers from her cousin. How many stickers does Susan have now?
- 10. A farmer had 75 apples in one basket and 42 apples in another. If he combined them and sold 31 apples, how many apples does the farmer have left?
