2. In a toy store, there are 32 action figures. If 9 of them are sold in the morning and 7 more are sold in the afternoon, how many action figures are left?
3. A box contains 10 packs of pencils, with each pack containing 24 pencils. If 4 packs are taken out of the box, how many pencils are left in the box?
4. Emily earned \$15 for mowing the lawn and \$8 for cleaning the garage. If she spent \$7 on a movie, how much money does she have left?
5. John has 5 baskets, with each basket containing 18 apples. If he gives 2 baskets to his neighbors, how many apples does he have left?
6. A car rental company charges \$45 per day for renting a car. If Susan rented a car for 4 days and paid \$20 for additional insurance, how much did she spend in total?
7. There are 24 students in a classroom. If 10 students are absent today, how many students are present in the classroom?
8. A store had 48 books in stock. If they sold 25 books in the morning and received 16 more in the afternoon, how many books are in stock now?
9. If a box contains 9 chocolate bars, and each bar has 5 rows with 8 pieces in each row, how many pieces of chocolate are there in total?
10. A farmer planted 5 rows of corn, and each row has 10 corn plants. If he harvested 3 rows, how many corn plants are left in the field?
