Rounding to the nearest ten

If the number that is being rounded is followed by a 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9, round the number up. If the number being rounded is followed by 0, 2, 3, or 4, round the number down.

or

If the number that is being rounded is followed by 5 or more, round the number up. Otherwise round the number down.

Procedure:

- 1. Draw a number line and label the numbers
- 2. Put a dot on the number to be rounded
- 3. Is the dot closer to the larger or smaller number
- 4. Round

Graphically, is the number being rounded closer to the smaller or larger number.
