2. A bakery sold 156 cupcakes in the morning and 82 cupcakes in the afternoon. How many cupcakes did they sell in total?
3. Sarah bought a backpack for \$45. She paid with a \$100 bill. How much change did Sarah receive?
4. A library had 289 books on the shelf. They lent out 125 books. How many books are still on the shelf?
5. John had 187 baseball cards. He gave away 54 baseball cards to his friend. How many baseball cards does John have now?
6. A classroom has 96 desks. If 23 students move to another classroom, how many desks are still occupied?
7. A farmer harvested 345 apples. He sold 112 apples at the market. How many apples does the farmer have left?
8. Sarah has 298 stickers. She gave away 75 stickers to her classmates. How many stickers does Sarah have now?
9. A store had 438 pencils. They sold 217 pencils. How many pencils are left in the store?
10. Tom caught 189 fish during his fishing trip. He kept 72 fish and released the rest. How many fish did Tom release?
