2. Emma had 385 marbles. She lost 94 marbles while playing. How many marbles does Emma have left?
3. A store received a shipment of 248 toys. They sold 123 toys. How many toys are still in stock?
4. David had 196 trading cards. He traded 54 cards with his friend. How many trading cards does David have now?
5. A zoo had 389 animals. They transferred 172 animals to another zoo. How many animals are still at the zoo?
6. Sarah had \$500. She spent \$245 on clothes and \$112 on books. How much money does Sarah have left?
7. A school cafeteria served 365 lunches on Monday and 143 lunches on Tuesday. How many lunches did they serve in total?
8. A farmer grew 476 tomatoes in his garden. He sold 211 tomatoes at the farmer's market. How many tomatoes are left?
9. Jason had 287 puzzle pieces. He used 96 pieces to complete a puzzle. How many puzzle pieces does Jason have left?
10. A pet store had 342 fish in a tank. They sold 131 fish. How many fish are still in the tank?
